

## Guidelines For FCC Worship Team Ministry

- Must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ that is consistent and growing through personal prayer, Bible study, and church fellowship.
- Be a committed participant at FCC, including regular attendance at Sunday services, regardless of whether you are playing that Sunday.
- Demonstrate technical competence as either a singer or musician.

### **1 Chronicles 15:22**

*Kenaniah the head Levite was in charge of the singing; that was his responsibility because he was skillful at it.*

- Singers and musicians must be comfortable on stage and expressive in their praise and worship before God.
- Be consistent in giving tithe to FCC.

## Commitment To A Holy Lifestyle

Worship team members are expected to live a lifestyle that is above reproach (1 Tim 3), avoiding even the appearance of evil. Being a minister who is up front adds extra responsibilities because people see us as examples of what a Christian should be like. Therefore, it is imperative that we consider the way we treat each other and carefully guard our hearts from impurities and pride.

### **1 Timothy 3:2-7**

*Be above reproach, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. Manage your family well and see that your children obey you with proper respect. Also, have a good reputation with unbelievers so that you will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap.*

## Schedule Requirements

Typically each band member will be scheduled 2-3 times per month and each vocalist will be scheduled 1-2 times per month, based on their availability and monthly service schedules.

Arriving on time and ready for practice is **essential** for each member! In order to present worship music that is both excellent in quality and anointing, an efficient practice is necessary. Rehearsal means re-practicing the music. Not looking at it for the first time...

- **Thursday Night Rehearsals:**  
3rd service team 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.  
2nd service team 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- **Sunday Morning Rehearsals**  
3rd service team 6:50 a.m. to 7:20 a.m.  
2nd service team 7:20 a.m. to 7:50 a.m.
- **Additional Thursday Night Rehearsals (Vocalists Only)**  
3rd service vocalists 5:20 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.  
2nd service vocalists 7:20 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

*All rehearsals are mandatory if you are scheduled to play that week.*

*Members who are continually late for practice or do not show up when scheduled may be asked to reconsider their membership on the Worship Team Ministry.*

## Dress Code

As leaders, Worship Team members must dress properly. Realizing that outward appearance is not judged by God, we affirm that others may be offended by improper attire. **"... if eating meat offends my brother, I will eat no meat."** Consequently, members are encouraged to be appropriately dressed for all services.
